REPAIRS At the present time. The Yellow Metal Sheathing stripped off the Bottom, and renewed upon Paper, All Treennails renewed this, from Stake next below the Wales, down to lower edge of Thickstuff at Floor Heads (being decayed) on each side, and down to a Level line Fore and Aft.
The following Planking is new in upper Course of Bottom, on the Port side, viz three Fore Hoods, two second from Foreward, one in Midship, and two After Hoods of English Oak, and South American Wood, and 20 feet of Plank sheer in Midship of Eng Oak, also 33 feet of Plank sheer in Midship on the Starboard side.
Three Planks of Deck new. Ship hung in Shores and Bottom Caulked.
