REPAIRS At the present time, the New Yellow Metal Sheathing being found wrinkled, and part indented; and the Caulking of Bottom very slack, the appearances being as tho' she had been on shore, it was ultimately proved that she had laid nearly dry for about six days, in Ipswich ^{wet} Dock. The Yellow Metal Sheathing stripped off Bottom Caulked Ship hung in Shores, and the Bottom re-sheathed with Yellow Metal on Felt. Wales and Topsides Caulked.

From imperfect Workmanship. The new lower piece of Stem put in at Ipswich last July, now replaced with new of English Oak properly fitted, and Bolted with Yellow Metal in lieu of Iron
