REPAIRS

at present all new Kulson (except the fore & the after lengths) of East India Teak fitted and bolted with yellow metal throat bolts of lodging and hanging. Knees of hold beams renewed of iron - Wales topsides and sheer strakes scraped bright and breasted found good and bolts where necessary renewed - the waterways of both decks caulked yellow metal sheathing repaired - The plank sheer waterways & beams the house timbers, knightheads, breasthooks & transoms the floors & Kulsons the planking outside and ceiling and the inner surface of the outside planking where seen are *very good* & the sheer and general form *unimpaired* - *Good*
