REPAIRS

Now done. The Yellow Metal Sheathing stripped off and renewed upon Tilt. Ship hung in Shores and Caulked from Wales to Keel. Treennails in upper course tied by Caulkers, a pair of Hanging Knees introduced to Hold Beam next abaft Main Mast, a new upper Pintle and Brace to Rudder, and sundry small jobs done to Oak Lodging Knees Ceiling &c & several planks in the main deck now sheathing.
