REPAIRS New sheerstakes fore & aft of Greenheart, new Hsprides of Red Pine, two planks the after shifts of wales in the starboard quarter 32 feet, on the Port Buttack six new after shifts 102 feet & seven filling timbers one new Iron breasthook, two side knees to the second hold beam down to the lower breasthook new forepiece of hog keelson six new top timbers on each side; the wales & eleven shakes of bottom from the wales to the turn of the bilge & recheenailed & the black shakes, timber shakes through bolted all the throat bolts of the hanging knees to the hold beams renewed with Yellow Metal, two new middle braces, hung, caulked from the keel overall & sheathed with Yellow Metal on felt, scraped bright & has in all respects complied with the rule

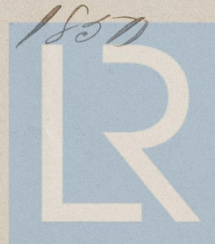
