# REPORT of SURVEY for REPAIRS.

No. 649 on the B<sup>th</sup> Sumatra Survey held at London Date Sept 6 to 16 1851  
Master W Johnson  
Tonnage 320 Built at Seabro When built 1840

Port belonging to Seabro Destined Voyage Ceylon  
If Surveyed Afloat or in Dry Dock In Mrs Tindall's Dry Dock

Last Survey, No. 13499 Port London Classed 11 A 1

REPAIRS at the present time under "Special Survey" for Continuation  
The Outside Planking from lower part of Water upwards scraped  
bright Treennails and Iron Bolts driven out at various parts for  
examination, all the Treennails tied by shipwrights in the eight  
upper staves of Bottom and about four days removed; the lowest  
Masthead new of Iron, and the next stave above it newly clothed;  
Ceiling in Bows repaired and at other parts of Hold; Copper  
Bolts in Lug Plates to Hold Beams clinched up their Rings being  
loose: Yellow Metal Sheathing stripped off the Bottom  
and removed upon Paper and the Bottom caulked; Cathrad  
new;

The Decks, Coamings, Decks and Hold Beam Bolts, inside and  
outside Planking, Treennails, Planksheer, Waterway, Beams, Knees,  
Hooks, Knight heads, House Timber, Keel, Kelson, Transoms, Floors,  
and Timbers of the Frame where they may be seen have been examined and  
are in good condition
