REPAIRS At the present time under "Special Survey" Rule for Continuation  
Sec No 54 and under S.S. Rule Sec No 63.

The Outside Planking from lower part of Males upwards scraped bright,  
 Iron Bolts and Treenails driven out at various parts for examination,  
 Yellow Metal Sheathing stripped off and renewed upon Felt; all the  
 Treenails in the three Sheer Stakes, and in the Side Stakes of Topsides  
 renewed; Treenails in Males, and Black Stakes tried by the Caulkers.  
 Bottom, Topsides and Sheer Stakes and Waterway Caulked.

A Stake of Girding removed on each side extending all Race & aft  
 at Bilge, and the Timbers examined at this part.

The Deck, Coamings, Deck and Hold Beam Bolts, inside and outside  
 Planking, Treenails, Planksheer, Waterway, Beams, Knees, Hook, Knight  
 Heads, Transoms, Keel, Keelson Floors and Timbers of the Frame where  
 they may be seen have been examined by us and appear to be in good condition.
