 a new Stemson of English Oak, Fore piece of Riding Keelson and the Fore Step
 new of India Teak, the three lowest Iron Hooks, taken off and refitted, the
 above Bolted with G^y Metal: nine lower Fore Floors of Ceiling, each side
 new, and one second Plank, from Forest all of English Oak, and through
 Ironnailed; three Chock, in Timber on each side in way of the above Plank,
 nine Planks of Ceiling below Bilges abaft Main Mast each side new of
 Eng Oak, Iron Bars, Aft^{er} and East India Teak, a new Eeking to Upper
 Deck Hook on the Port side of English Oak, a new Upper piece of Stem
 English Oak, Knee of Head taken down, repaired, and refitted,
 Bowsprit, Main Stay and Main Top Mast Bar, stays new,
 Wale, Caulked, also Butts of Topsides.

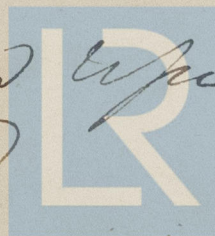
