new stanchions on each side, new decks end forward, new gripe
new pointers aft 750 feet of new ceiling in the flat of the

to the hold beams & several in the stringers renewed with Yellow
Metal, windlass refitted & new purchase to it, decks and
upper works caulked, scraped bright & several trenails & bolts
cut for examination & found in good condition as well as the
planks through which they pass, the plank sheers, waterways,
beams, hawse timbers, knight heads, breast hooks, transoms
the floors, keelsons, planking outside & inside are all in good
condition & has preserved her original form & sheer
