REPAIRS Copper shepped off, several bolts & beenails driven out for examination and found in good condition, caulked from the keel to the gunwale opened at the turn of the bilge a shake taken out free & aft on both sides, & found all the timbers sound except three on the Port side & five on starboard side abreast to the Mizzen Mast, which have been compensated for by a pair of Iron Riders extending over them
