REPAIRS at the present time. Yellow Metal Sheathing stripped off the Bottom, and renewed upon Paper, Caulked throughout. Lower Deck Hook new of English Oak, both Fore Hoods of Lower Deck Waterway, both Fore Hoods of lower Stakes of Lower Deck Spirketting: The upper portion of Apron (20 ft long), the Knight head on the Port side (25 ft long), and the upper portion of Stemson (10 ft) new of English Oak and East India Teak, ^{is} 2 1/2 trimmed of fore side of Stair^e Knight head and a Filling introduced. The Iron Hook betwixt Decks taken off and refitted, a new middle piece to Deck Beam next abaft Main Mast of East India Teak: Buttocks brightened, and one after Hood of Planking on each side new of East India Teak, and about 100 Treennails renewed at various parts.
