REPAIRS

At the present time with a view to reclassing upon the black Dipthong Character, the condition of the Sheer Stakes, Limber Stakes, and Keelson not being in the high state required for any character above that grade, and the Owner expressed his unwillingness to go into any repair beyond the following which has been done

The Outside Planking from lower part of Wales upwards scraped bright, Bolts and Treennails driven out at various parts for examination Yellow Metal Sheathing stripped off the Bottom and renewed upon Paper; Caulked from Keel upwards, Treennails all tried from light water mark upwards, and about 500 renewed; a few Graving pieces inserted in Sheer Stakes and in Keelson.
