REPAIRS

At the present time the upper deck, has been surveyed in conformity with the Society's Rules Section 54 scraped bright from the copper up. Sides & turn aits drawn out for inspection.

The upper deck (new) & Hoggings the upper and lower deck batts the outside planks through which they pass plank sheers waterways & turn aits, keelson timbers, apron & stern knightheads, Breast Hooks, & beams the floors & keelson the outside, and turn aits passing through from the copper up, the ceiling the port and inner surface of the outside where it could be seen & the frame - all in good condition. The keel is straight.

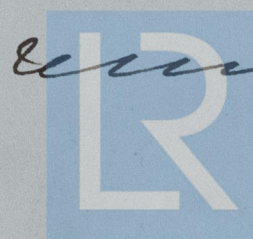
