REPAIRS

This Vessel has been surveyed with a view to raise her class and we find that the waterways that had been reported to be of spruce are of yellow pine and the upper deck beams are well secured with double wood loding and six pairs of diagonal cross hanging knees - The Ceiling is all of black matack or Red Pine - on examining the frame by the removal of the lumber strokes and part of the Ceiling aft, timbers of the frame are a mixture of Birch and black matack to the extent of 40 feet amidships but all the rest of the frame, beams, knees & planking appear to be of black matack or Red Pine
