REPAIRS At the present time 2 planks in ceiling, shekel and counter blocks  
found the floor bolts of the keels of the deck and hold beams sound  
some new beams;

relative to Scraped Bright from the Copper up, bolts and nuts  
written out for inspection,

The upper decks and lower Whopper and lower deck bolts  
and the planks through which they pass, plank beams, cutwaters, floors

planking outside from the upper top, the ceiling the frame and inner
