REPAIRS now done. Not under any request for Survey. The Owners reminded that she might be surveyed with a view to the X, the reply was "that the Owners wished to defer such Survey for the present".

Outside Stalk<sup>o</sup>. 160 feet of Sheer Stakes new of African Oak.  
Port side 120 feet of Sheer Stakes, of African Oak and English Oak,  
one Plank of Topside and Pine & two Fair Boards of Male English Oak.  
Timbers in way of the above Planting not seen by us, but 'tis reported  
that eighteen Rollings were introduced on each side of African Oak  
from 4<sup>ft</sup> 6<sup>in</sup> to 5<sup>ft</sup> 6<sup>in</sup> long. 26 ft of Plank sheer on the Port side new.  
The whole of Deck from raised D<sup>o</sup> of Star<sup>o</sup> new of 3 Yellow Pine: Caulked  
above Yellow Metal Sheathing.

Present Condition of the Ship almost of sound D<sup>o</sup> of new. Hold not yet seen for London.
