At the present time stripped doubley Caudle and weathered hull with yellow Metal, upper works Coulled, new poll Bitt & wormell top galant fore & mizzen 4 pairs of iron hanging knees to hold beams and 3 pairs to the deck beams and generally overhauled, fitted with new Cham bolts
