REPAIRS at present from having been out of 53 hours during her late voyage from Calcutta
 Entirely new Main-Middle & Fore Keels fitted - bottom stripped - 17 Planks of the bottom renewed on the Starboard and 5 on the larboard side being nearly chafed & badly worn - 5 new Planks of bilge curving on the Starboard side which have been additionally thro' bottom - Caulked from Keel to waterways and bottom kedged & dunnage yellow paint - Fall damage repaired
