At the present time from damage New Stern frame doubling at the bows  
 the Chocks and Head, from other causes New upon Breast Hooks opposite  
 and refitted the Ship shatted all over and generally over hauled  
 Has been Survey in conformity with the Societys Rules Section 54  
 cropped bright from the holes in bottles and turnails driven out  
 for inspection

The upper deck and coverings the upper and lower deck bottles the  
 inside planks through to which they pass, the plank sheers waterways  
 transoms have been brought heads Breast Hooks transoms the plankway doubling  
 and other planks outside the turnails at bottles passing through from the hull  
 the existing the inner surface of the outside planks and the frame  
 here it could be seen all in good condition the form of the ship unaltered
