At present time, eight stakes of a wide upper deck fore and aft
 new of yellow pine, new piece of Kelson 32 ft long fitted under main ship
 topsides, sheer stakes, and water scraped bright found very good.

Upper or main decks, and comings, the upper and lower deck bolts,
 the outside planks, and ceiling this which they bear, the plankstems,
 waterways, and beams, house timbers, knight heads, breast-hooks, and
 transoms; the floor and keelsons; the keel and other; the planking
 outside, and the frame and inner surface of the outside planking
 where seen are sound and good, sheer and general form of the ship
 unaltered.
