REPAIRS

At present bottom stripped, caulked, resheathed with yellow metal over paper, rudder refitted, plank sheers topsides, sheerstrakes & wales scraped bright found good, upper or main decks and coverings, the upper and lower deck bolts, and the outside planks and ceiling thin which they pass, the plank sheers, waterways, and beams, house timbers, knighthead, breasthooks and transoms, the floors and keelsons the keel & rudder, the plating outside, and the frame and inner surface of the outside plating where seen are sound and good, sheer and a general form of the ship unaltered.
