REPAIRS to the present time under Special Survey for
Continuation Rule Sect 54, Wood Sheathing and yellow
Metal stripped off and scraped bights from tight water masts
upwards including plank sheen waterways and 4 awc timbers
and several bolts and screws driven out at various parts for
examination.

The following is as present repairs with 6 main seats
twenty four feet of after part of keelson two after heads of main
beam or sculler ^{through} stripped according to Rule one New Main Seat
Beam, and Main Deck entirely renewed ^{with yellow pine} from bow of
Pulp forward, Carthage from keel upwards including Deck
& Waterways: Males Sheathing with rose two sheaths from
Blackstrakes upwards and resheathed with yellow metal
over Sate
