REPAIRS At the present time yellow metal strips off the Bottom and being in Show Condition and strengthened from Keel to Gunwale the yellow metal bolts in Rings having been cleaned on iron rings which were entirely rusted are now renewed with yellow metal rings and well washed also restrengthened with yellow metal over any Poles
