## REPAIRS

at present from having been on shore on a former voyage — New fore piece of Main Keel and lower piece of gripe, hung in shows all the yellow metal sheathing stripped off except the eight upper sheets or courses — Treennails renewed on both sides from the floor heads to the upper part of bilges — after deadwood & Keel and Stern Post additionally three bolts and all the uncovered seams Caulked and the bottom repainted with yellow metal on paper — The fore piece of Keelson having been found defective has been renewed of African Oak and the fore piece of Way of lower Clew The new Keelson & Keel & Stern three bolts with yellow metal

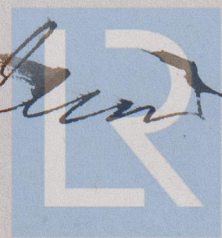
