At present, yellow metal stripped off the bottom and renewed over felt, vessel hung, caulked from keel to waterway seams of upper deck. new midship piece of keelson of African oak thro bolted with $1\frac{3}{8}$ yellow metal ~~xxx~~ in every floor, new hog keelson 46 long of American oak. 3 fore booms of bottom, new of American elm on the larboard side, foremast piece of keel of English elm, new, keel to stern post of African oak. Scarpes of keel & garboard seams listed with lead new lower yards and topsail yards.

This Vessel has been scraped bright from the light water marks upwards at the Owners wish, & found by us good.
