REPAIRS

Rest 46-7 years

Now done, in accordance with the Rules, Sect 54, the vessel's sides have been scraped bright from light water mark to the waterway seam. Treennails and bolts driven out from various parts for survey. On examination we found the upper deck and comings, the upper ~~and lower~~ deck bolts, and the outside planks through which they pass, the plank sheers, waterways, and beams, the house timbers, knightheads and breasthooks, transoms, floors and kiltons; the keel and rudder; the outside planking, and the treennails passing through from the light water mark upwards; the ceiling inside, and the frame and inner surface of the outside planking where it may be seen all appear in good condition; and the sheer and general form of the ship appear to remain unaltered.
