## REPAIRS

Having been requested to survey this vessel for damage I at some time examined her Condition otherwise & finding her 1<sup>st</sup> Deck Hanging knees in several instances some requiring refastening 2 Becms broken & intimated that the defects would have to be made good. The vessel being at the time up for sale was sold immediately after & an annual survey called by the purchaser. On this occasion I tried the Larb<sup>r</sup> Sheer Strake & found it to be very defective in way of some of the brails & bolts the Main Hatch (after) Deck beam & Hold Beam under it both broken one deck beam abaft the former doubled in way of winch Chock another deck beam forward broken & Hold Beam adjacent defective. Recommended the vessel to be scraped from the metal sheathing upwards. Recommended repairs required made good. The Owner has in reference to this stated that from having the vessel engaged he is unable to enter into any repairs.

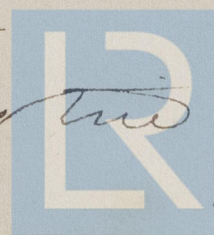
