REPAIRS Now done - scraped bright from light watermark upwards, and treenails and bolts driven out for inspection. One plank of sheer strake on Port quarter, and one plank of topside on port bow renewed with Dantric Oak. Yellow metal sheathing stripped off, and renewed on paper, in way of the doubting, and on felt below. Bottom recaulked. The upper deck and comings, plank sheers, waterways, beams; the hawse timber, knight heads, breast hooks, transoms, outside planking, keelson, timbers of the frame, and fastenings, have been examined where possible, and have been found satisfactory.
