REPAIRS Now done partly for damage Particulars in Special Report
The fore piece of Main Keel renewed with English Elm the lower piece
of Main Stem renewed with English Oak also the fore and after piece of fore
Keel renewed with Elm. The fore heads of Garboard on each side and
five planks of Bottom renewed with Elm and several graving pieces
in Bottom the whole of the above were damaged by being bruised and
badly warmed. The yellow metal stripped off the ship being in shreds
and caulked from keel to deck, the Bulwarks renewed, and
one fore head of Sipside on starboard side of aft part. And the Foremast
replaced with new
The Bottom freshed with yellow metal on felt

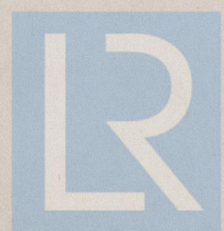
