REPAIRS at present from Collision abroad (which
which had been repaired temporarily there)
new Head Knees, & Chucks, tails & figure of the
house Chocks down & have pipes taken
out and refitted — not from damage
Yellow metal sheathing stripped off
and preparatory to Continuation next
year the planks from the light water line to
the Wales have now been dubbed bright and
trunnails driven out for survey & found good
the bottom has been Caulked & sheathed with
Yellow metal on top & felt above
