For Damage, now done, the Yellow Metal sheathing renewed on
Felt, the vessel hung in shores and Caulked from the keel to the
top of the wales, part of the false keel refitted and renewed, the front
piece of the knee of Head renewed, and the chutes and Hawsepipes
rebolted.
