REPAIRS at the present time of damage sustained by stress of weather in her passage from Sydney to London. More particulars in Special Report.

Nine Kaighie Stantions on the Starb<sup>d</sup> side new, the whole of Bulwarks and part of Main Rail new, Main and Fore Channels repaired and refastened; the Knee of Head and its fittings repaired and made secure, a new Main piece to Rudder, Bowsprit Fished, Mast heads examined, and the Ship Caulked from Wood Sheathing at Middle of Wale upwards including the Upper Deck
