REPAIRS at the present time. S.S. 40 C 4 54

The Outside Planking from light water mark upwards scraped bright
Nails and Iron Bolts driven out at various parts for examination
about 70 feet of Planking in Lopside Fore Body on the Port side renewed
with English Oak, a few Graving and three pieces inserted at various
parts along the Wale, Caulked outside and two Oak Lodging
Knees to Upper Deck Beams stuck & replaced with new

The condition of the outside Planking aloft, and of the
Limbers seen in way of new Planking, not being in the high
condition required for her present *Character, the Master's attention
was called to them, and he informed us of the disinclination of
the Owners to go to any great expense that the A would suit this
use of her.
