REPAIRS

Now done, quarter-timber on each side renewed with English oak. 4 timbers of the stern renewed with Dantzic fir: one plank in the stern renewed with English oak the rest of the planking of stern renewed with Dantzic fir. Saffrail renewed with Dantzic oak. Roughtree-rail. Topgallant-bulwark in length 25 feet on each side renewed, and the vessel caulked in quarter and stern.
