Now done, the Ceiling and deck repaired, two planks in the starboard bow and one in the larboard bow and quarter outside renewed with American Oak.

The main piece of Rudder renewed with English Oak, the Yellow Metal sheathing renewed on Telt, and the Vessel Caulked from the keel to the sheer strake and part of the deck.
