grounding in the Bay of Bengal, more of

Yellow Metal Sheathing stripped off and renewed
upon Paper, Ship hung in Shaves, Caulked from
Keel upwards to middle of Wales, and about 60 feet
of False Keel, Cinches thick, renewed.

Not of accident. A few Bolts of Yellow in knees, and
Wisers, having been found with their
heads broken off, now replaced with
new Bolts
