Yellow Metal Sheathing stripped off and renewed
upon Paper, Ship hung in Shores, Caulked from
Keel upwards to middle of Wales, and about 60 feet
of False Keel, 6 inches thick, renewed.

Not of accident. A few Bolts of Yellow in knees, and
Widers, having been found with their
heads broken off, now replaced with
new Bolts
