## REPAIRS

at present Quarter pieces off - Stern berthing inside & outside renewed 14 ft after Wood of Sheer streak on each side & 3 after Wood of Topsides on each side removed & latter renewed of Pitch pine former of Teak New Taffrail & Moving Chocks one New Bulwark stanchion & part Rail on Port side - Nelson defective as one of the scarpes - defective parts removed & 23 ft (Anchor stock) (pusher) supplied by Teak finally caulked from Metal line to Waterways
