REPAIRS at present Quarter pieces off - Stern beathing inside & outside renewed 14 ft after Hood of Sheer streak on each side & 3 after Hoods of Topsides on each side renewed & latter renewed of Pitch pine former of Leak New Taffrail & Moving Chocks one New Bulwark stanchion & part Reel on Port side - Nelson defective as one of the scaphs - defective parts removed & 23 ft (Anchor stocks) pushed up by Leak finally caulked from Metal line to Waterways
