REPAIRS

At the special request of Owners we attended this Ship on the above named date with a view to her being S.P for continuation upon Restoration. We found the Yellow Metal Sheathing stripped off the Bottom, Wales and Topsides scraped bright and in hand dubbing upper course of Bottom bright: and as far as this Survey proceeded we found all the False Keel torn off except the foremost piece, the Main Keel badly bruised and cambered, the Ship much deformed in her sheer on the Starb^d side, and a large proportion of the Treennails which we saw driven out of the Wales and upper course of Bottom were broken and otherwise defective: The Hold was much lumbered up with large Cases of Machinery, and Water Tanks we recommended that they be removed from the Ship as the Ceiling at various parts of the Hold seemed to be defective, the Keelson and Floors require close examination //
