PAIRS. Now done:— The yellow metal stripped off the bottom and the vessel caulked from keel to gunwale including the flat of upper deck and poop, 3 hold beams forward renewed of African oak, a pair of staple standards added to front of poop, main-bowthing and filaments on deck repaired, and yellow metal renewed on felt over the old doubling.
