REPAIRS Now done. - two shifts of topside amidships on Starb<sup>d</sup> side, and one d<sup>o</sup> on Port side renewed of teak; side Counter-timbers on each side renewed of English Oaks, 8 after hoods of topsides and sheer strakes in way of new side counter timber on each side renewed of teak, and English Oaks; new decks of yellow pine vessel caulked from keel to gunwale, as also the new decks, and re-sheathed with yellow metal and felt.
