REPAIRS now done: - 9 strakes on Starb^d side, and 10 on port side of upper deck, also 3 short pieces forward on each side renewed of yellow pine; one new beam of Dantzie oak added to upper deck at the aft side of windlass. The ends are secured with a pair of Iron hanging knees. Vessel caulked from metal line upwards, and the deck windlass overhauled, pumps new of Iron: standards to windlass lifts renewed, new chain-in-ast, rails and tiering repaired and the yellow metal sheathing raised one sheet.
