REPAIRS Now done, two planks of sheer strake, and one of topside on port-side renewed of teak, one piece of covering-board, 3 rough-sawn timbers, and a piece of rough-sawn-rail on port-bow renewed of English Oak, one piece of waterway on port-side renewed of teak, and two skiffs of deck of yellow pine, two pairs of iron knees added to hold beams amidships and a pair of iron knee-riders aft, each bolted with yellow-metal, the new-work caulked, and yellow metal patched.
