REPAIRS at present from being Wormed - all the lower strake of Wale on both sides removed (except the starboard after hood) and renewed forward with English & Dantye oak hoods and the rest of the strake of Dantye fir all the bolts of the lodging ^{of lower deck} knees renewed with iron thro new wale plank's timbers of the frame exposed sound - one new fore hood of the bottom on larboard side Caulked from the second beam below wale to the black strakes both buttocks fitted & sheathed with 14 inch Dantye oak deck repaired under the Cathead Yellow Metal Sheathing repaired & raised to the second plank of the wale.
