REPAIRS

An order was left to survey this vessel for the A.E.I. classification, and an examination found her partly laden; the main-hold being nearly full of Bricks and Cement; the deck defective on both sides in the waist and mostly on the port side, the fore-mast ant, and about to be renewed; the sides of the vessel could not be examined, there being no stages and the position of her such as to prevent her being thoroughly surveyed. Sent Notice Card to the Captain requesting the vessel to be placed in drydock the hold to be cleared, and to shift the defective deck on each side amidships, the same has not been attended to and the Owners have written a Letter countermanning the order left for survey.
