## REPAIRS

Now done Removed, and renewed, the after piece of kelson with Seak through bolted with 1 1/2 in G Metal; the sides kelson from the new mast forward with iron bark through bolted in every third floor with 1 1/2 G Metal the remaining short bolts iron New Seak stemson knee, bolted with 1 1/4 G metal the lower wood breasthook removed, and replaced with one of iron, overhangs of Greenheart metal bolted. New mast steps of Greenheart. The Sheerstrakes, Waterway, & two adjoining seams of deck, Caulked also below forward in way of the new work. The metal sheathing patched and dressed
