at present from having been on shore at Hudsons Bay
 Part new false keel fitted for wales & aft new gripe
 the six lower pieces of ice chocks removed and caulked
 under the ship hung in shores and bottom (doubling)
 Caulked ^{also} wales topsides and waterways Caulked. New
 iron whelps fitted to Windlass — And not
 from damage the doubling of bottom (which is Copper
 bottom) at present scraped bright & found sound & good
 the bottom sheathed with yellow metal on paper
 and one hold beam removed that interfered with the
 necessary room in main hatchway and an original
 shelf which had been fitted at second futtock heads
 tripped down & bolt cut & replaced & repaired
