REPAIRS now done 11 Roughtree stanchions on the Port bow, renewed two fore hoods of doubling of sheer-strake, and one piece of original sheer-strake of Cantyic oak, fore piece of waterway in way of the same, and covering-board renewed of Cantyic oak, roughtree-rail from midships forward on the Port side and main bunting in way of the same renewed, new fore channel on Port-side and the vessel caulked from forward to after part of fore rigging from metal up, and the deck to the same extent, the waterways and stanchions the whole length of vessel caulked.
