REPAIRS now done, 7 Porthole stanchions on the Port side of Poop renewed and the Porthole rail in way of the same; berthing, rails, and deck fittings repaired and made efficient; Plank of lead repaired, new main and berthing rails on the Starboard side and the fittings partly renewed, new Bowsprit and fore-mast; Channels repaired, as also the quarter galleries on the Port side, vessel caulked from metal upwards, and the flat of upper deck, bottom sighted and found in good Condition.
